## LETO: Cutting-edge medical science for breast cancer

Modern methods are available nowadays so that breast cancer may be diagnosed early and treated with minor procedures.

The latest diagnostic methods, such as **tomosynthesis** and **breast MRI**, aim at early and reliable diagnosis, while **stereotactic breast biopsy** is a minimally invasive technique which constitutes a necessary step towards diagnosing non-palpable lesions. With regard to the treatment methods available, the contemporary trend in breast surgery is performing minor procedures - such as **sentinel lymph node biopsy** - which offer proven oncologic safety and protect patients from undesirable complications.

These issues were discussed during a Scientific Meeting focusing on "New facts in the diagnosis and surgical treatment of breast cancer", organized by LETO Maternity Hospital's Breast Center. The Meeting was attended by internationally-acclaimed specialist physicians from the European Institute of Oncology in Milan.

As noted during the Meeting, as the aesthetic result after a breast intervention is becoming important, advanced surgical techniques have been developed, such as skin- and nipple-sparing mastectomy or **conservative mastectomy**, to address the issue. This technique, in combination with immediate breast reconstruction, offers to the breast cancer patients a new breast from the very first moment, so that they can continue to their lives without experiencing the feeling of amputation.

World-renowned Professor Paolo Veronesi of the European Institute of Oncology noted, "Breast cancer affects 1 in 8 women, in the western world. These days, not only can patients be cured, but they should also have a normal family, social and sex life, provided they receive proper treatment from the very beginning by experts."
