With great success was completed the ceremony of delivery of the ambulance of the Diagnostic and Therapeutic Center of Athens YGEIA to the Municipality of Marousi.

The ambulance is fully equipped based on EKAV specifications and is immediately available to the citizens of the municipality of Marousi.

The ceremony was completed in the presence of the Vice-President of the Board of Directors of "YGEIA", Mr. Themistocles Xaramis, the CEO Mr. Pasxalis Bouxouris, the Private Banking Manager of Marfin Bank Mr. Alexis Komninos and many members of the Executive Council of the Municipality of Marousi and citizens of the municipality.

The Mayor of Marousi, Mr. Georgios Patoulis thanked the Management of YGEIA and stressed that it is an honor for the citizens to be offered such a unit for transporting patients.

On his side, the Vice-President of the BD of "YGEIA" Mr. Themistocles Xaramis underlined that the offer took place within the scope of the effort of the Mayor and the Executive Council for the upgrade of health services of the Municipality toward the residents, as well as of the Program of Social Responsibility of the Hospital.

He also assured the Mayor that YGEIA will be an aid in every similar effort. He also took the opportunity to request the contribution of the Municipality in the acceleration of the procedures of creating a pedestrian bridge in front of the building of "YGEIA", on Kifisias Boulevard, in order to prevent serious accidents due to the increased traffic in the area.

Mr. Patoulis responded positively to the proposal of Mr. Xaramis and committed to moving the procedures along for the study design, granting of the permit and the construction of the pedestrian bridge at the most dangerous point of Kifisias Boulevard.
