HYGEIA: Free-of-charge first-aid kits for the schools of Filothei-Psychiko

HYGEIA Hospital donated 23 fully-stocked first-aid kits as well as medicinal products (essential/non-prescription) to the schools of the Municipality of Filothei-Psychiko. The action forms part of the Hospital's Corporate Social Responsibility initiatives, in response to the Municipality's request for pharmaceutical support to all its local schools (kindergartens, primary schools and high schools).

During a special ceremony that was held in the Blue Bell municipal building on Wednesday March 27, representatives from HYGEIA Hospital, accompanied by one of the Hospital's ambulances, handed over the first-aid kits to the Mayor, Mr Pantelis Xydakis. The ceremony was attended by the deputy mayors and council members, as well as teachers and students from the local schools.

During the ceremony, the Mayor of Filothei-Psychiko stated, "The priority of our city council is to provide whatever is necessary so that our children may attend school in a safe, contemporary and fully-equipped environment.
